Data for visitors to Australia for less than 12 months




France is Australia's 17th largest inbound market, reaching 85% of pre-pandemic levels in FY2023-24. 2 in 3 of French visitors are solo travellers.






France is forecast to return to pre-pandemic levels in in 2026. 2 in 3 French visitors come to Australia for a holiday or visiting friends and relatives (VFR).

Forecast visitor growth






